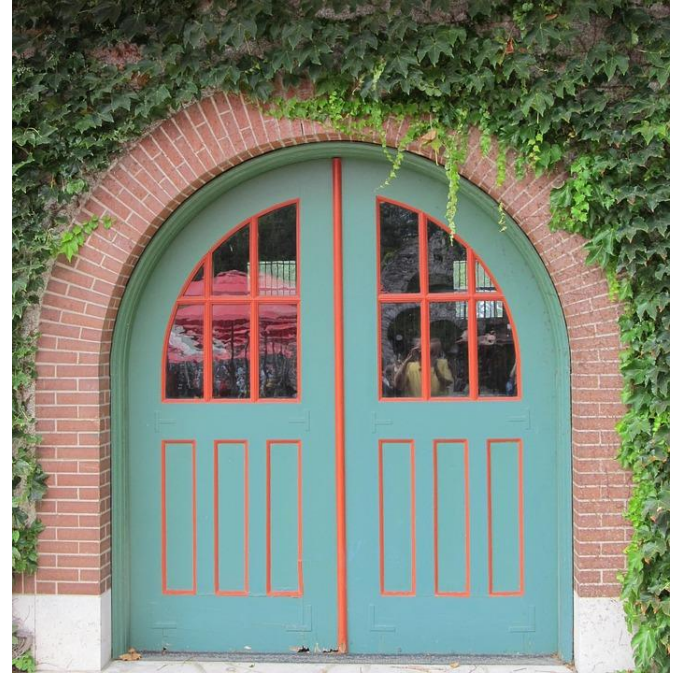

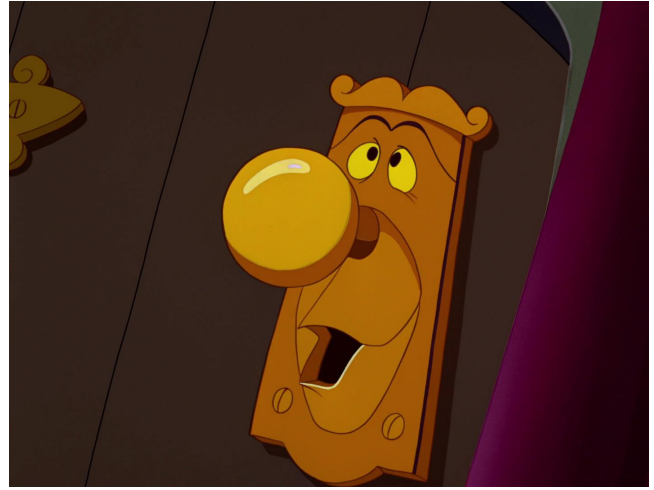
- Commitment to inclusion
