Dan Cherubin - Dan has been the Caleb T. Winchester University Librarian at Wesleyan University since July 2016. He has more than 20 years of experience in managing library and information services, including work at The American Music Center, The NY Public Library for the Performing Arts, The Wildlife Conservation Society, Rabobank International, the Tokyo American Club and, most recently, as the Chief Librarian and Associate Dean at Hunter College in New York. Dan has a BA in ethnomusicology from Bard College, an MA in Media Studies from the New School and a MS in Library Service from Columbia University. He has presented at ACRL, SLA, IFLA, IAALD, and the NextLibrary Festival. Outside of making the library a better place for all, Dan's research interests include information theory and social epistemology, cross pollination in popular music, the history of information sharing and hoping the NY Rangers might actually win it all again.

Lizanne Payne - Lizanne is Shared Print Program Officer at the HathiTrust Digital Library, where she is responsible for planning and implementing a shared print program among the 125 HathiTrust member libraries. Prior to joining HathiTrust in 2016, Lizanne served for 6 years as planning consultant for some of the most significant shared print programs in the United States, including:

- Eastern Academic Scholars Trust (EAST)
- Western Regional Storage Trust (WEST)
- Research Collections and Preservation Consortium (ReCAP)

Prior to her consultancy work, Lizanne served for 20 years as Executive Director of the Washington (DC) Research Library Consortium (WRLC), a consortium of nine university libraries that collaborate to support a shared digital library system and a shared offsite collections facility.

Matthew Sheehy - Hired as the associate university librarian for collections, Matthew Sheehy is the interim university librarian at Brandeis University. Prior to joining Brandeis, Sheehy held leadership positions in academic libraries most recently in the Harvard University Libraries and at The New York Public Library. Matthew has served on the Program Steering Committee and Shared Print Advisory Group for the HathiTrust, co-led the Boston Library Consortium's Heads of Resource Management. He holds an MA and MLS from the University of Buffalo, and a BM from the University of Hartford.

Susan Stearns - Susan is the Executive Director of the Boston Library Consortium (BLC), which includes 18 academic and research libraries in New England. Prior to joining the BLC, she was Vice President of Strategic Partnerships for the Ex Libris Group and had earlier held senior positions in marketing, product management and professional services at a number of library automation vendors, electronic publishers, and search engine companies. The BLC acts as the fiscal and administrative host for the Eastern Academic Scholars' Trust (EAST) shared print program and Susan is Project Director with responsibility for administration and management of the program, which includes 47 libraries in the Eastern United States
