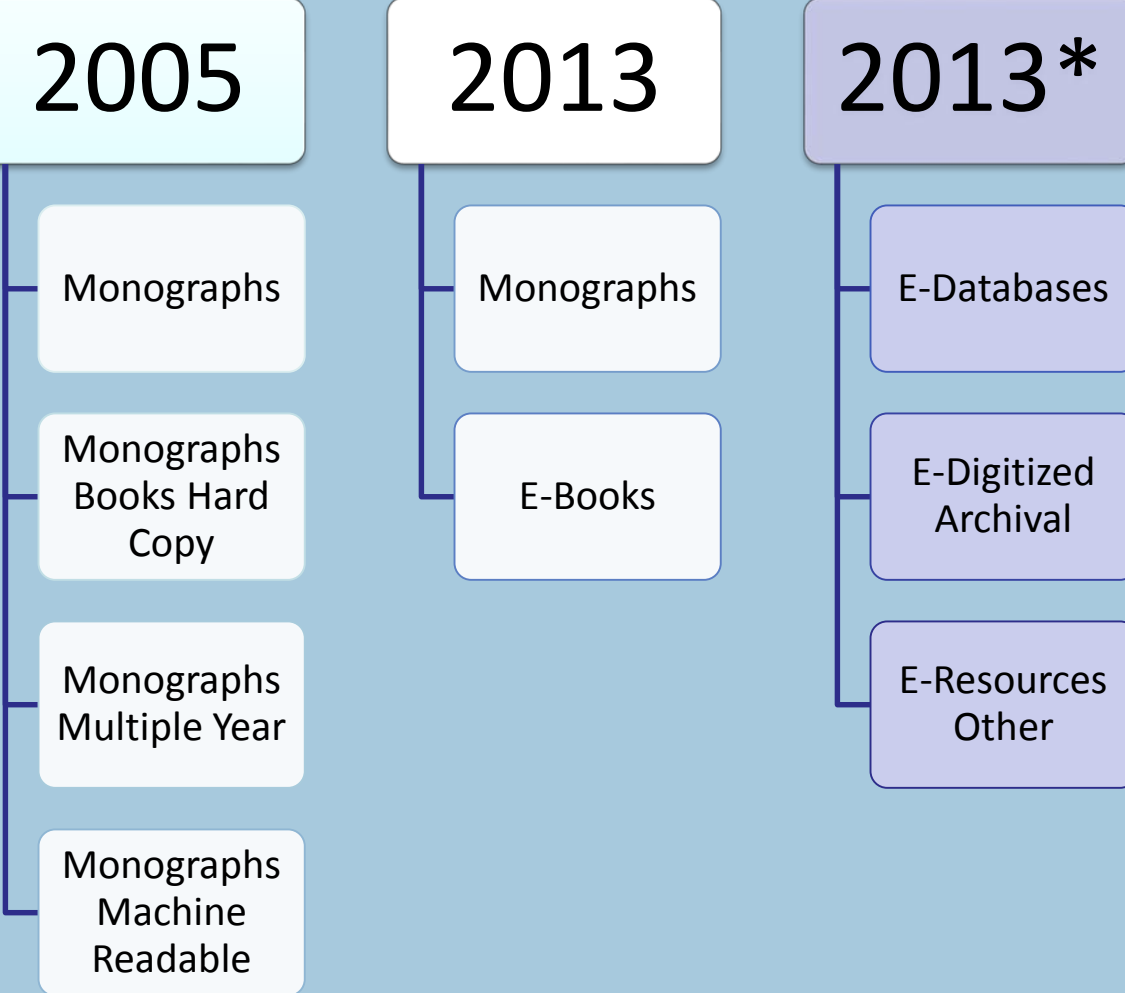

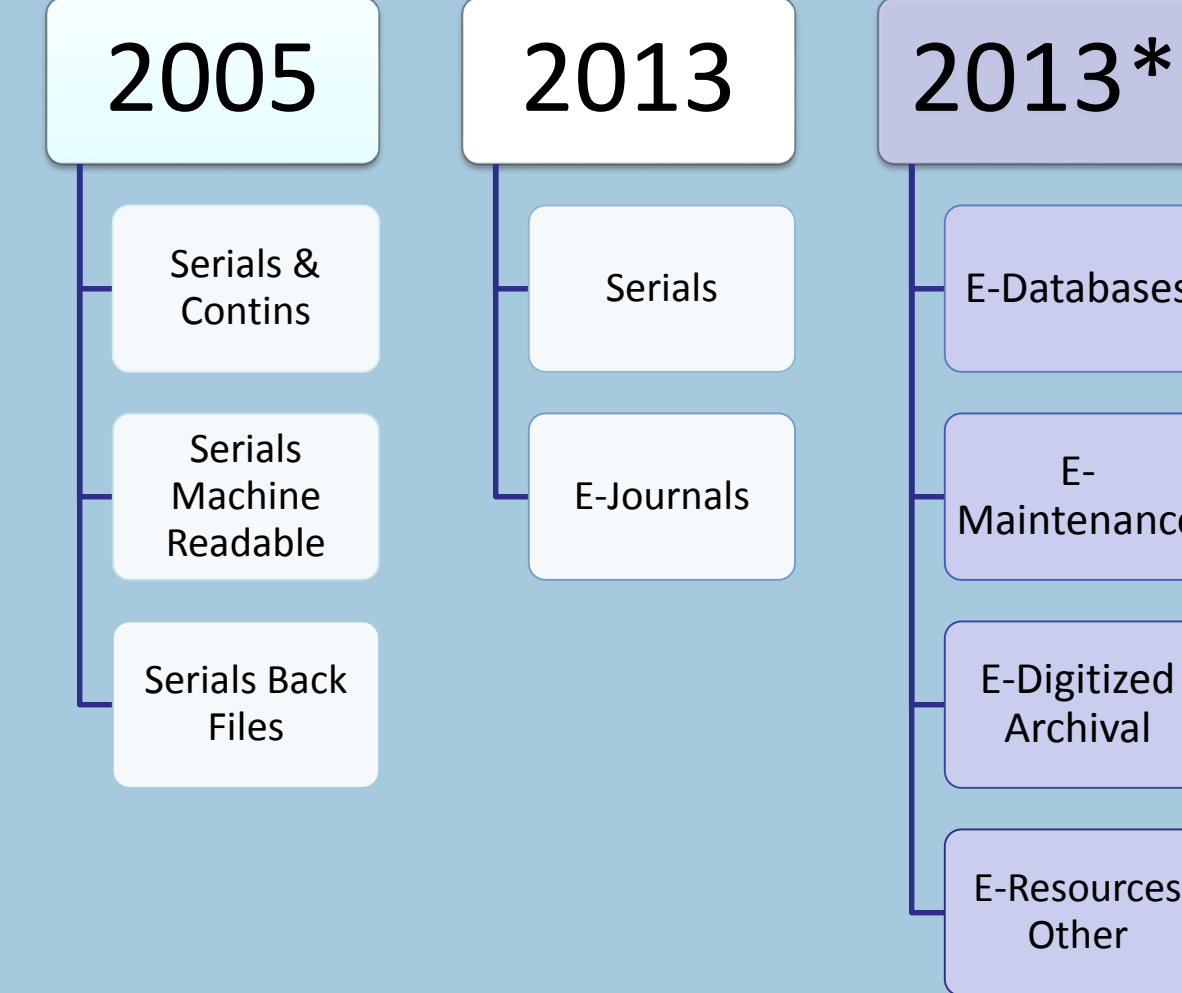

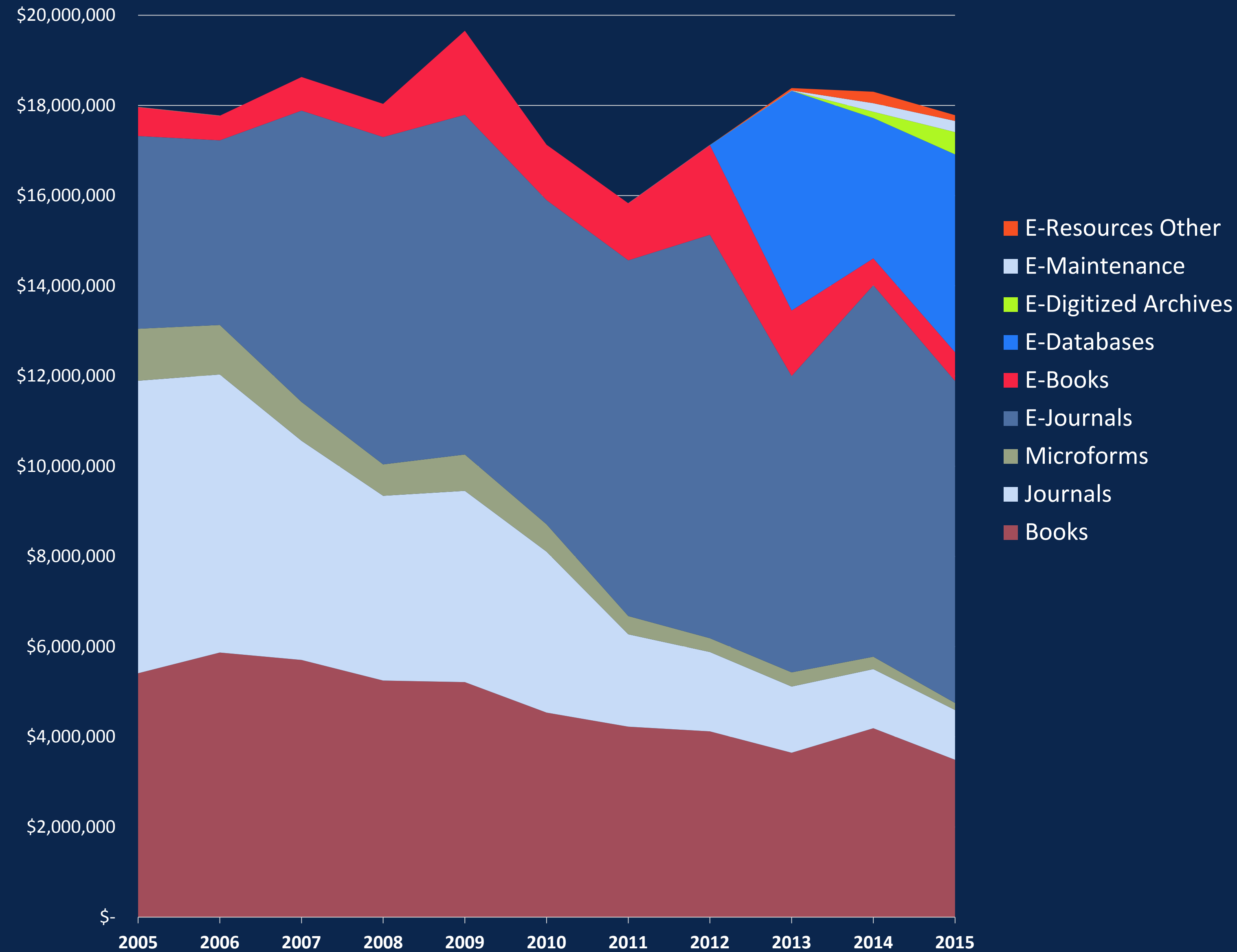
The Evolution of Book Expenditure Codes



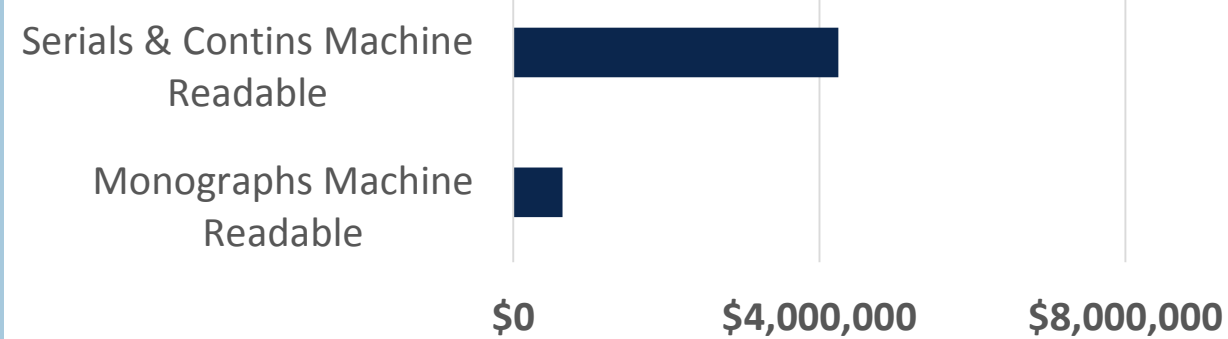
The Evolution of Serial Expenditure Codes



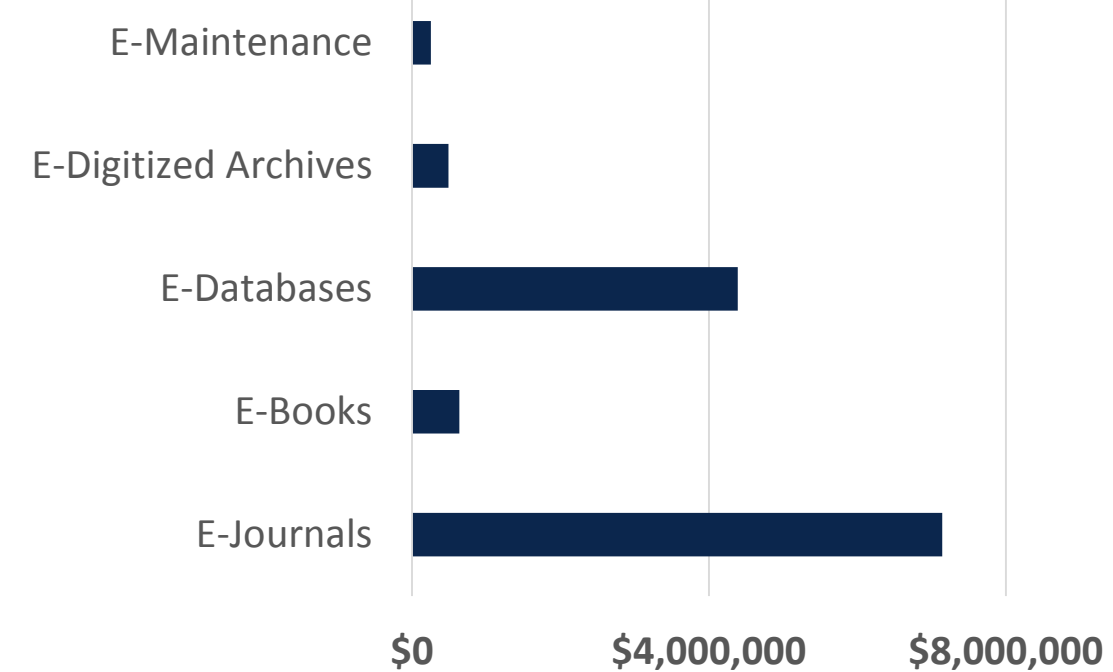
Budget Trends: 2005-2015
