Write a script for a movie or TV show that portrays First Americans accurately and showcases how Native American government shaped the U.S. government.



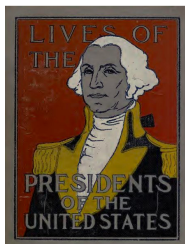
Evaluate Whether the Government of the Roman Republic Would Have Made the Internet a Public Utility

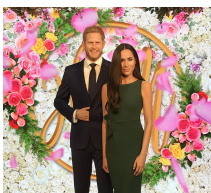
Assessing, Revising, & Writing School Social Media Policies
