Archaeological Field School, University of Missouri-St.Louis, Session I: Cahokia Mounds State Historic Site, June 12-30, 2000, and Session II: Arrow Rock, Missouri, July 10 - 28, 2000. This six-week archaeological field school will spend the first three weeks at the Cahokia Mounds State Historic Park exploring portions of a Mississippian (A.D. 1000-1400) earthen mound. The second three weeks will be spent in Arrow Rock, Missouri, exploring its industrial and African-American heritage. Excavations in Arrow Rock will concentrate on a stoneware pottery factory (1854-1870) and a late nineteenth/early twentieth-century African-American community.
